Focus on making one point - if your audience can only take away one thing what would it be? You may share more, but this forces clarity.



Make your point in an interesting way.

- » Tell a brief & relevant anecdote
- » Use a quote
- » Make an analogy
- » Define a word
- » Use a statistic



Tell stories.

Storytelling is a powerful way to express significant meaning in a short period of time. Plus, stories help us connect more deeply with the communication.



Reiterating what you hear increases your chances of understanding & responding on target. Plus, it buys time to formulate a response.



Dial back the detail.

The brain does a good job of filling in the blanks, so share less detail & then confirm understanding.



Shorten your sentences.

Keep them brief & tight. Check out these killer fillers.



A delayed response shows thoughtfulness & control.
